Pune to Hampi Trip Plan - 3 Nights / 4 Days

Pickup point - Deccan Gymkhana Bus Stop, Pune

Day 1: Departure from Pune

Your Pune to Hampi road trip begins at 8:00 pm as we leave Pune by Non - AC bus / tempo traveler. Get ready for an overnight journey filled with excitement as our travel community heads towards the historic land of Hampi.

Day 2: Explore Hippie Island & Adventure

- Reach the hotel by 7–9 am, freshen up, and enjoy breakfast.
- Start the day riding bikes around Hippie Island.
- Try a thrilling coracle ride and adventurous cliff jumping at Sanapur Lake.

- Visit Durga Temple, Sugriva's Gufa, Anegundi Village, and Chintamani Temple (a Ramayana heritage site).
 - End the evening with a magical sunset at Anjanadri Hills.
- Post-sunset, explore local cafés for dinner. Enjoy bonfire time with your new trek buddies or rest at the hotel.

Day 3: Hampi Sightseeing Tour

- Early check-out after breakfast and begin your guided Hampi sightseeing.
- Visit iconic landmarks like Vijaya Vittala Temple, the Stone Chariot, Queen's Bath, Elephant Stables, Lotus Mahal, Royal Enclosure, and Pushkarni.
- Explore the Underground Shiva Temple, Hampi Bazaar, Badavi Linga, Narasimha Temple, Sasivekalu Ganesha, and Virupaksha Temple.
 - Wrap up the day with a scenic sunset at Hemkunta Hills.
 - After dinner, begin the overnight return journey on your Pune to Hampi trip.

Travel Suggestions for Mumbai Participants

Option 1 - By Train

• Take the Vande Bharat Express (22225) – Ticket cost ₹550–650.

- From Pune Station, take the Metro (₹15) to Chhatrapati Sambhaji Garden or Deccan Gymkhana. Both stops are just a 5-minute walk from our bus pickup point at Deccan.

Option 2 - By Road

- Shared cabs are available from **Dadar** or **Vashi** (around ₹500). If you come by cab, join our bus at **Navale Bridge** or **Katraj**.
- You can also take an MSRTC Shivneri bus from Dadar.
 - Travel time: 5-6 hours (buses halt at multiple stops and for food at Lonavala).
 - Get down at Pune Station Depot or Swargate Depot (as per your bus route) and take an auto to Deccan.

How to Reach Hampi, Karnataka

Planning a Hampi India trip is easy, thanks to good air, rail, and road connectivity. Here's how you can reach this UNESCO World Heritage site:

By Air - The nearest airport to Karnataka Hampi is Hubli, about 160 km away, with domestic flights from major Indian cities. Another option is Kempegowda International Airport in Bangalore, around 350 km from Hampi, which has both domestic and international flights.

By Train - The closest Hampi railway station is actually Hospet Junction, just 13 km away. Trains from Bangalore, Hyderabad, Goa, and other cities stop here. From Hospet, you can take a taxi, rickshaw, or local bus to reach Hampi.

By Road - Hampi is well-connected by road. Regular state transport and private buses run to Hospet from different parts of Karnataka and nearby states. You can also drive down or hire a cab for a comfortable Hampi Karnataka road trip.

Best Time to Visit Hampi India

The best time to visit Hampi is from October to March, when the weather is cool and pleasant. During these months, temperatures stay between 15°C to 30°C, making it perfect for Hampi sightseeing, exploring ancient temples, and outdoor activities.

Avoid the summer season (April to June), as it gets very hot and tiring for travel. The monsoon (July to September) brings heavy rains, which may cause travel delays and make some temple sites harder to visit.

If you're planning a Hampi trip from Pune or Mumbai, winter is the most comfortable season to enjoy the ruins, temples, and landscapes at their best.

Q. How to reach Hampi from Pune?

- By Road: ~585 km, overnight buses available.
- By Train: Pune to Hospet Junction (HPT), 13 km from Hampi.
- By Air: Fly to Hubballi (160 km) or Bengaluru (350 km), continue by road/train.

Q. How to reach Hampi from Mumbai?

- By Road: ~725 km, sleeper buses are common.
- By Train: Mumbai to Hospet Junction (HPT).
- By Air: Fly to Hubballi or Bengaluru, continue by taxi/train.

Q. How to reach Hospet?

Hospet Junction railway station is the nearest to Hampi (13 km). From there, taxis, autos, and buses connect to Hampi all day.

Q. Distance between Hampi and major cities?

- Pune to Hampi distance: ~585 km
- Mumbai to Hampi distance: ~725 km

Best Time & Weather

Q. What's the best time to visit Hampi?

October to February is ideal — pleasant weather, green surroundings, and the famous **Hampi Utsav festival**.

Q. What is Hampi weather like?

- Winter (Oct-Feb): Cool & perfect for sightseeing
- Summer (Mar–May): Hot afternoons
- Monsoon (Jun-Sep): Green but rainy

Sightseeing & Activities

Q. What are the must-visit Hampi tourist places?

Virupaksha Temple, Vittala Temple & Stone Chariot, Lotus Mahal, Elephant Stables, Hampi Bazaar, Hemakuta Hills, Anjanadri Hills (sunset).

Yes, bikes are easily available on the Anegundi/Hippie Island side. Carry ID, helmet, and check local rules.

From government-run hotels (KSTDC Mayura) to hostels, homestays, and boutique guesthouses near Kamalapur and Anegundi, options are available for all budgets.

Q. Are there hostels and homestays in Hampi?



Yes, Hampi has budget-friendly hostels like Zostel, and family-friendly homestays around Anegundi and Kamalapur.

Q. What food is available in Hampi?

South Indian thalis, filter coffee, and simple continental menus at Hampi Bazaar and Hippie Island cafés.

Q. Any good coffee shops or restaurants?

Yes, Hampi is known for relaxed riverside cafés and local restaurants serving both Indian and global food.

Festivals & Culture

Q. What is Hampi Utsav?

A 3-day cultural festival held annually (usually in winter) with music, dance, and heritage shows across the ruins.

Q. Are movies shot in Hampi?

Yes! From Jackie Chan's The Myth to Bollywood and South Indian films, Hampi has been a popular shooting location.

Safety & Rules

Q. Is Hampi safe for solo travelers and women?
