Overview

Korigad Trek

Korigad (also called Koraigad, Koarigad or Kumwarigad) is a hill fort located about 20 km south of [Lonavla](#) in Pune district, Maharashtra, India. Its date of construction is not known but likely predates 1500. It is about 929 meters above sea level. The planned township of Aamby Valley is built over the fort's southern and eastern foothills. The closest village is [Peth](#) Shahpur about 1 km north of the fort. The fort is located about 929 m 3,049 feet above sea level, rising over 200 meters or 660 feet higher than the neighboring valleys. To the east, there lie two artificial lakes part of the Aamby Valley project which later drains into the Mulshi reservoir. There are two lakes on the top of the fort. This fort can be visited at any time of the year. Even a night trek during summer gives a nice experience. There are a lot of [camping](#) sites on the fort. There are three temples on the fort which provide ample cover. The Korai Devi temple can accommodate 25 persons.

Korigad Fort History

During 1657 Korigad was captured by Chhatrapati Shivaji Maharaj along with Tung, Tikona, [Visapur](#), [Lohagad Fort](#) and few more. Twelve forts were kept with Chhatrapati Shivaji Maharaj after the treaty of Purander, Chhatrapati Shivaji Maharaj kept Korigad Fort with him which proves the importance of this fort. March 11th, 1818, Col Prothar attacked this Fort after three days of fighting with Valour by Mavalas, the British blew off



the storeroom of ammunition using cannon fire and the fort was lost to British on March 14th, 1818.

- The leader's decision will be final, and all the members should abide by it.
- We do not destroy or dirty the archaeological, historical monuments, natural habitat on the trek.
- Swimming is not allowed in the lake or water tank on the forts. Locals use that water for drinking.
- Putting your feet in water tanks or on the canon is not allowed on our treks.
- Any addiction is strictly prohibited, e.g. drinking, smoking, chewing tobacco anyone caught doing it will have to exit the trek without a refund and travel back on own expense.
- People caught smoking or drinking alcohol will be asked to exit the event on an immediate basis.
- Please do not carry or wear any valuables, ornaments, jewellery, etc. If carried, then we Do Not take any liability for the same.
- Rock Climbing, Rappelling, Trekking, or any adventure activity is potentially risky. For all these events, you are at your own risk. Organizers are not responsible for any accident or compensation in whatsoever manner.
- We should strictly follow the code of conduct to avoid troubling our fellow trekkers or other people from our group or outside.
- Listening to music on earphones or Bluetooth speakers is not allowed while trekking.

Korigad is a hill fort located about 20 km (12 mi) south of Lonavla in Pune district, Maharashtra, India.



Korigad is a beautiful hill fort located at around 20 kms from Lonavala near Amby Valley. This is a fort which you can visit during any time of the year.

Korigad Fort trek is a very easy trek located near to touristy town Lonavala. Standing at an elevation of around 920 meters from sea level, Korigad fort top gives some stunning view of the Aamby Valley city along with the Tung and Tikona fort.

1. Can we drive to Peth Shahpur?

Yes, you can drive to Peth Shahpur.

2. What is the distance from Mumbai to Peth Shahpur?

The distance from Mumbai to Peth Shahpur is approximately 125 km, which takes about three hours by car.

3. How far is Peth Shahpur from Pune?

Peth Shahpur is around 90 km away from [Pune](#), and it takes approximately two and a half hours to drive there.

4. How many days are required for this event?

This event can be completed in one day.

5. Is there food available on Korigad fort?

No, there is no food available on Korigad fort. However, you can find food at the base village.

6. How much time is required to climb Korigad fort?

It takes about one hour to climb Korigad fort (one way).

7. Where can we park our cars?

You can park your cars at the base village, but please note that parking is at your own risk.

8. Is there any parking charge?

Yes, there is a parking charge.

9. Are toilets available on Korigad fort?

No, there are no toilets available on Korigad fort. However, there are toilets available at the base village with eastern-style commodes.



10. Can solo female travelers sign up for these events?

Yes, many solo female travelers join our events. We have a ratio of 60% or more male to female participants.

11. Are kids allowed on treks?

Kids below the age of 15 are allowed on treks but only under parental supervision.

12. What type of food will be provided?

Only vegetarian local home-cooked food will be available.

13. Is there phone connectivity?

There is limited phone connectivity available for most cellular services.

14. Is cash payment or spot payment accepted?

Cash payment is not accepted. Registration is only possible with 100% upfront payment through Paytm, UPI, NEFT, IMPS, or the payment gateway. On-the-spot payment is not accepted as we need to make advance bookings for transportation and other arrangements.

15. Will I get bottled water?

Normal well water will be provided. Please carry a power bank if you need to charge your phone as there is no electricity available.

16. How is the weather now?

The current summer temperatures range from around 20°C at night to 39°C during the day.

17. Can we smoke or drink alcohol?

No, smoking or drinking alcohol is not allowed during the event. People caught doing so will be asked to leave immediately.

18. Can we listen to music on a Bluetooth speaker?

Listening to music on earphones or a Bluetooth speaker is not allowed while trekking, and Bluetooth speakers are not allowed inside the homestay.

19. How do I make payment?

You can make the payment online on our website by visiting the "How to Register" section.



20. How do I get to Korigad?

How to get there : Korigad is situated close to Lonavala. If you are travelling by car, reach Lonavala via the Mumbai-Pune highway. Once you reach Lonavala head north and take the Jalvayyu marg. Pass the Simbi point and then take the Vayyu marg.
