Short Itinerary – Ujjain & Omkareshwar Tour

Day 1: Evening departure from Pune/Mumbai by sleeper Volvo. Overnight journey to Ujjain.

Day 2: Arrive in Ujjain. Visit Mahakaleshwar Jyotirlinga, Mangalnath Temple, and Harsiddhi Mata Temple. Evening Shipra Aarti at Ram Ghat. Overnight stay in Ujjain.

Day 3: Morning visit to Kal Bhairav Temple. Proceed to Omkareshwar Jyotirlinga. Overnight return journey to Pune/Mumbai.

Day 4: Arrival in Pune/Mumbai with divine memories.

Ujjain – Omkareshwar Spiritual Weekend Itinerary

From Pune / Mumbai | Two Jyotirlinga Darshan

Day 1: Pune / Mumbai to Ujjain (Overnight Journey)

Begin your weekend spiritual journey with an evening departure towards the sacred city of Ujjain.

- 06:05 PM – Andheri East (Hanuman Road)
- 06:20 PM – Bandra East (Kala Nagar)
- 06:55 PM – Sion (Chunabhatti)
- 08:00 PM – Thane (Teen Hath Naka)
- 08:20 PM – Kalyan (Bhiwandi Naka)

Pickup Points – Pune

- 05:30 PM – Kharadi (Sleeper Bus only)
- 06:00 PM – Sangamwadi / Sassoon Hospital
- 07:05 PM – Bhujbal Chowk / Jagtap Dairy
- 07:40 PM – Nashik Phata

Seater Bus Pickups

- 05:30 PM – Shivaji Nagar (Wakdewadi Bus Stop)
- 06:30 PM – Nashik Phata

Travel Mode: Seater Bus / Sleeper Bus / Tempo Traveller (based on group size)

Enjoy ice-breaking activities, music, and a brief introduction with the Trip Captain. A short dinner halt (self-paid) will be taken before continuing the overnight journey to Ujjain.



Day 2: Ujjain Temple Visits & Shipra Aarti

Arrive in the holy city of Ujjain and begin the temple trail.

- 09:00–11:00 AM – Arrival and hotel check-in (standard check-in at 11:00 AM), freshen up and breakfast
- 11:30 AM–01:00 PM – Darshan at Mahakaleshwar Jyotirlinga
- 01:00–02:30 PM – Lunch break (timings may vary based on temple queues)
- 02:30–04:00 PM – Visit Mangalnath Temple
- 05:30–06:30 PM – Evening aarti at Harsiddhi Mata Temple
- 06:30–07:30 PM – Attend Shipra Aarti at Ram Ghat
- 07:30 PM onwards – Explore the Ujjain Corridor, shopping and local street food

Optional: Bhasm Aarti at Mahakaleshwar Temple (subject to advance booking and availability)

Overnight stay in Ujjain

Local travel by auto rickshaw

Meals included: Breakfast and Lunch

Day 3: Omkareshwar Darshan & Return Journey

Begin the day with early morning temple visits and continue towards another sacred Jyotirlinga.

- Early morning – Darshan at Kal Bhairav Temple
- Proceed towards Omkareshwar Jyotirlinga



- Lunch en route (vegetarian)
- Post-lunch – Visit Mamleshwar Temple and spend time at the ghats of the Narmada River
- 07:00–08:00 PM – Begin return journey
- 10:00 PM – Indore drop

Optional: Visit Maheshwar if time permits

Dinner halt en route (self-paid)

Meals included: Breakfast and Lunch

Day 4: Arrival in Pune / Mumbai

Arrive back in Pune or Mumbai between 12:00–01:00 PM as per bus schedule, concluding a spiritually enriching weekend journey.

How to Reach Ujjain

Ujjain is well-connected by road, rail, and air, making it easily accessible from various cities in India.

1. Ujjain By Air



The nearest airport to Ujjain is Devi Ahilya Bai Holkar Airport (IDR) in Indore, approximately 55 km away. From the airport, you can take a taxi, bus, or private vehicle to Ujjain (around a 1.5-hour drive).

2. Ujjain By Train

Ujjain Junction (UJN) is a major railway station with direct trains from cities like Mumbai, Delhi, Pune, Ahmedabad, Jaipur, and Bhopal. Several express and superfast trains connect Ujjain to different parts of India.

3. Ujjain By Road

- From Indore: Approx. 55 km (1.5-hour drive) via NH52. Buses, taxis, and private vehicles are available.
- From Mumbai: Approx. 650 km (12-14 hours by bus or car).
- From Pune: Approx. 650 km (12-14 hours by bus or car).

Regular government and private buses run between Ujjain, Indore, Bhopal, and other major cities. You can also hire a cab or drive to Ujjain for a comfortable journey.

Ujjain to Omkareshwar

The distance from Ujjain to Omkareshwar is approximately 140 kilometers (around 3 to 4 hours by road), depending on the route and traffic conditions. The most common route is via NH52 and SH27. You can travel by private vehicle, taxi, or bus for this journey.

Inclusions

- **Transportation:** Pune/Mumbai round trip by Non-AC Seater or AC Sleeper bus (as selected). Local travel by auto/cab for two days.
- **Accommodation:** Hotel stay on Double / Triple / Quad sharing basis (as opted).
